This unit forms a gas-detection squad consisting of a leader and 3 men.

One of the junior non-commissioned officers is assigned additional duty as gas non-commissioned officer.

Of the junior non-commissioned officers 3 are Master Sergeants and 6 are Technical Sergeants.

Of the 165 privates 29 may be replaced with foreign military service volunteers with 6 in the Company Trains. The remainder to be assigned as determined by the unit commander.
